LETTER FROM PASTOR ALISSA

Dear Friends in Faith at Spokane Valley UMC-

Thank you for picking up this Charge Conference booklet and taking the time to review the items for action at Charge Conference this year! We will gather after worship on November 30th in the Fellowship Center following Coffee Chat. We will begin our Charge Conference at 10:45am and all who wish to attend are invited to do so. Please note that all who attend have "voice" but only members have "vote". As the Presiding Pastor of the South Spokane Missional Cohort, of which our church is a part, I have been commissioned and authorized by our District Superintendent, Rev. Daniel Miranda, to lead the business of our Charge Conference once again this year.

At the beginning of our time together, we will ground ourselves in scripture using Luke 9:12-17 as our guide and engage in reflection on the story of Jesus feeding the 5000. We will then move to voting on the items that require a vote: the 2026 Pastoral Support Worksheet, the 2026 Proposed Leadership Nomination Slate, and the 2026 Proposed Budget. In addition to these "traditional" votes, we also have the joy of affirming the continued Candidacy of Zach Reiber, our Lay Leader, who is seeking ordination as a Deacon in the United Methodist Church! We will continue to vote year by year to affirm Zack's continued status as a certified candidate until he is recommended and received into Provisional Membership as a Deacon by the Pacific Northwest Annual Conference Board of Ordained Ministry (potentially as early as June of 2027). Lastly, we will take a vote of affirm Dr. Shawna Beese's application to be certified as a Lay Speaker.
