Position/Title: Children's Sunday School Teacher

Reports To: Coordinator of Christian Education

Collaborates with: Pastor, Coordinator of Christian Education, Nurture and Education Team and Staff-Parish Relations Team

Brief Mission Statement: To provide instruction on biblically based programs for children in a loving, safe and secure environment that develops their understanding and faith in Christ.

Service Recipients: Children between the ages of 4 and 12, along with their family members.

Hours: Average of 4 hours each Sunday (8:30 a.m. – 12:30 p.m.)

Responsibilities:

Essential functions of this position include, but are not limited to:

- Arrive by 8:30 a.m. to prepare the Sunday School classroom. Be ready to greet children and family members.
- Provide quality instruction of pre-planned weekly lesson plans with the ability to differentiate instruction to meet the needs of students with unique learning needs
- Provide positive behavior support and manage classroom behavior
- Maintain weekly attendance records and follow up on absenteeism. Provide to Coordinator of Christian Education for tracking in Simple Church.
- Maintain a safe and secure environment by not allowing any unauthorized or unscheduled person(s) to enter the classroom at any time during the church service. These people include Sunday School Teachers, helpers/workers, staff, parents, and guardian of current children. Ensure that every child is checked in and out directly to the person(s) listed on the registration form
- Follow all CDC cleaning guidelines for the room, toys, and supplies used during class after each service. Remove any dangerous or broken toys.
- Utilize current supplies and notify Coordinator of Christian Education when additional supplies are needed.
- Develop positive relationships with parents, students, Coordinator of Christian Education, volunteers, and Church staff members

- Contact Coordinator of Christian Education if unable to teach Sunday School due to illness or an emergency AT LEAST 24 hours prior to event
- Fill out Time Sheet on a weekly basis and turn it in to the Coordinator of Christian Education at the end of each month

Qualifications:

- Fully embrace the purpose, values, and beliefs of Spokane Valley United Methodist Church. *"To invite people to follow Jesus, to love others and transform the greater community through the grace of God."*
- Be dependable and committed to being here each week to provide quality instruction with a cheerful, confident, and loving manner.
- Must be able to communicate in a calm and positive manner with children, parents, and Church Staff members
- Have, or ability to obtain, a current CPR and First Aid Card.
- Education, or experience, in working with young children
- Ability to flex instruction/communication style to meet the needs of the students

Performance Evaluation: Shall be based on a review process with Staff-Parish liaison, Coordinator of Christian Education and Pastor.
