

Generous: A Four-Week Stewardship Series on Growing in Grace and Generosity November 3 to Celebration Sunday, November 24, 2024

Many of us were taught as children that it is important to share with others, but did you know that, increasingly, studies of the human brain are showing that we are actually "hardwired" to thrive through actions of generosity? There is an increasing amount of research that shows that being generous is good not only for those who receive, but for those who

give! Yes, a growing
number of the world's
leading universities and
medical centers are
discovering, through the
study of brain science and
other fields, that being
generous is good for both
individuals and for society.
At the University of



Pennsylvania, Dr. Femida Handy teaches a course called, "The Science of Generosity: Do Good...Feel Good!" based on the most current research. Research has found that individuals that practice generosity, whether through financial gifts, volunteer service, or advocacy, regularly have measurable positive outcomes in terms of health, stress reduction, and improved relationships.

(Cont. from pg 1) don't have enough, or they work hard for their money and are exhausted, or they are worried about holding on to what they have. In this worship series, we'll be rethinking our relationship to money and especially how to find contentment with what we have and how we can be a conduit for God's generosity using the resources we have been blessed with. We get lots of messages about what is important, what the "good life" is, and everything we need to do – and have – to achieve it. Still, so many of us remain unsatisfied, chasing after the next thing in search of fulfilment. But there is good news for us! God desires for us to have lives of contentment, freedom from worry, and joy in abundance. And Jesus shows us the way there. As we learn how to find our contentment in God, we will also discover the beauty in giving. Our lives will be evidence that the good life is the generous life – a life through which the grace of God flows into the world.

As we enter the traditional season of stewardship in the month of November, we will be studying how God has created us to be generous. Through a four-week series from November 3 to November 24, we are going to focus on ways of being generous through worship and an optional daily devotional. This series is designed to help individuals and families reflect on God's generosity and then in turn understand that we are in fact woven together as human beings, created in the image of this generous God for community with one another. It is no wonder that when we are generous, our very health, relationships and well-being increases and our communities and God's world benefit. If you can think of anyone who might benefit from the side effects of generosity, consider inviting them to this series!

In the coming days, you will either receive in the mail, or have the opportunity to pick up from the church, our annual Stewardship Letter and 2025 Pledge Form along with resources to help guide you in prayerful discernment of how best for you and/or your family to reflect the generosity of God back to the world.

Plan now to join us weekly for this grace-filled worship series that will involve our entire congregation. Mark your calendars as we're planning a special Celebration Sunday during worship on November 24 where you'll have the opportunity to offer your 2025 Pledge Forms and have them consecrated for our coming year of mission and ministry.

Our goal for this season of stewardship is that each of us and our entire church family will grow deeper in relationship to God and in gratitude, and then take steps to grow in being generous. We are literally made to give in relationship with God, each other, and God's world!






United Women in Faith




Mark your calendar for the Harvest Dinner!
